


#### A Party at the Meadows

They also set up a activity for children to take part in, this involved using a short length of drain pipe already cut down to size then start filling.

#### **Towpath Action Group**

One of the popular walks from the village is along the canal, especially for the less able because there are no banks to climb. We are very fortunate to have the Llangollen canal running through our area. Designed by Thomas Telford it starts in the Welsh Hills above Llangollen, carrying water diverted from the River Dee. The scenery is spectacular as it crosses over the river via the famous Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, a World Heritage site. The towpath is very popular with folks, walking and enjoying the peaceful, traffic free scenery and



wildlife as the quiet water flows. We are often reminded of the benefits of exercise and this is certainly a safe place for walking, running or cycling. Unfortunately the towpath needs upgrading. It's not too bad from Gledrid to Moreton but after that, to the Moors, it's uneven and muddy and slippery in wet weather. It's no good for the less able or for pushchairs and wheelchairs.

The canal is managed on our behalf by the Canal and Rivers Trust (CART), but they say they have no money for the towpath upgrade, so a local group has been formed called the Towpath Action Group to show that there is local demand for this work to be carried out and to work with CART to obtain grant funding.

If you appreciate using the path we really need new members to push for this work to be carried out.

If you have an account with BT or another provider, advise them that you have received a call that you suspect is a fraud made by a confidence trickster (scammer). BT will be interested in any information you give them.

You can also contact HMRC and inform them as well because they never contact a customer by phone, text or e-mail.

Please remember the old sayings careless talk costs lives, mind your own business, you don't need to know that so take a running jump. Your bank account information is private between you and your bank and no one else, so tell them to push off.
